Ad-hoc Basis Attendance

Emergency attendance at Early Birds will be possible on an occasional basis and payment will be due on arrival or by ParentPay within 24 hours.

The breakfast menu is served between 7:45am and 8:20am and will include the following:



Cereal and Milk – Cornflakes, Rice Krispies, Weetabix, Shredded Wheat, Ready Brek, Cheerios, Shreddies, porridge

Bagels / Muffins / Toast (Best of Both brand) with butter and either jam or marmalade

Frubes and Fruit

Milk, hot chocolate, fruit juice or water

Please note not all items on the breakfast menu will be available every day

Activities

There will be occasional themes and special activities.

We encourage children to walk or cycle to school.

If your child travels to school on a scooter/ bicycle they will need to take it through the playground doors to the cycle/scooter rack in the playground. Please be aware: it is always best to safely secure your child's equipment left in the cycle rack. The main school gates will be opened at 8.30am, locked after 9am and then opened again at 3pm.
