This term's value is: Aspiration

Maths:

Place value - Count to at least 50, forwards and backwards from any given number. Recognise place value in teen.

Addition and subtraction - Add and subtract numbers within 20, using objects or number lines to support.


Direction – Describe position, direction and movement of objects and people, including left/right, forwards/backwards.

Multiplication - Count in steps of 2, 5 and 10 forward and backwards. Count repeated groups of objects, of the same size to represent multiplication. Recognise missing numbers in multiplication patterns.

Measurement – Compare the weight of two or more objects. Compare and estimate the capacity of two or more containers.

English – 'Beegu' and 'The Odd Egg'.



In English this half term we will be using the text 'Beegu' to explore poetry, rhyming words, dictionaries and definitions. We will also be reading 'The Odd Egg' from which the children will further develop their information writing skills.

Help at home: Try to find words that rhyme and encourage your child to create real and nonsense words which rhyme. Think about what we can learn about a character from pictures and what they say or do. Questions- why do you think they did that? What is the character thinking? How can you tell they are happy?

Year One Learning

Children learn best through play, exploration and discovery.

We are developing the children's independent learning by having introduced a 'checklist' of learning tasks the children know that they must complete during the week to a high standard, in addition to teacher guided tasks. The children all have time to complete these activities as well having the opportunity to put into practice learning and ideas of their own.

Science: This term we will be starting to think about how seasons change, for example temperature. This will be ongoing throughout year 1.

Help at home: When on walks, comment on the weather and how it is changing as the months go on. What other changes can they notice?

Forest school will be taking place most Fridays this half term. Please bring in wellington boots and a waterproof jacket to keep in school.

PSHE: This half term we will be thinking about difference and what this means. We will consider how to manage different opinions. We will be using our texts to help the characters have confidence in their differences.

Help at home: Please encourage an open minded attitude and positive responses to 'difference'.

Art and DT: The children will be developing Design and Technology skills to make puppets linked to our English texts.

Help at home: Encourage the understanding of how to join different materials such as fabric, plastic, wood as well as how to use other interesting objects such as leaves or stones. Have a go at making your own puppet at home.

RE: We will be learning about Judaism and what it means to live as a Jewish person.

Help at home: Discuss different religions and their similarities and differences.

Geography: We will be learning about how to use a simple compass and the four cardinal directions. We will use this knowledge to guide Beegu home!

Help at home: Look at maps and identify north, south, east and west. Think about which direction they would need to travel to get to a certain location. Make maps and give directions to the map user using north, east, south, west.

Help at home- these are ideas you can do with your child at home. It would be fantastic for children to bring any home learning into school to share with the class. These are optional. Homework will be sent separately.
