## Road Safety at Building Site

Please can parents be aware of the construction site next to Dulwich Leisure Centre on Crystal Palace Road. There are large vehicles delivering at all times of the day, including school drop off and pick up times, and as a result sometimes the pavement is obstructed. We would recommend that you alter your walking route to the other side of this pavement for the duration of these works (until summer this year). Workers dressed in orange are assigned as traffic wardens and will help you or your children cross the road safely if the pavement is obstructed. We would recommend that you talk to your children about this if they are walking this way home or to the Dulwich Leisure Centre by themselves, so that they can manage this situation safely.
