Hair & Nails

Please make sure hair extensions are the same colour as the child's hair.

Please do not send children to school wearing coloured nail polish fingernails / toenails.

Also all long hair must be tied up or plaited to help curb the spread of head lice.



Please can we remind parents not to stop on the zig-zag lines outside the front of the school. Even stopping for a second to drop off your child, makes the entrance very dangerous. Please help us keep everyone safe and find somewhere else to stop.
