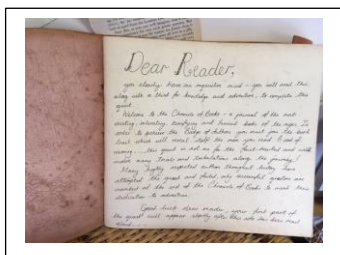

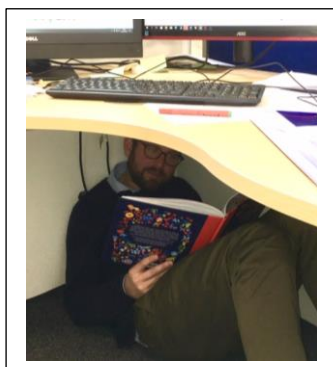
## Reading Challenge
