## Start of the School Day

There have been a few queries about the start of the school day. As a reminder, the school day **starts** at **8.55am**. This is when registers are taken, so please ensure your **children are in the classroom by 8.55am**. Currently we keep the gates open until 9am to help with access and flow for parents. **However if your child is coming through the gate at 8.55am then they will be late** for the start of the day because registration starts at 8.55am. From this time, they will have missed registration and so we have to take each child's name to ensure we know they are on site. This is to keep them safe and allows us to manually enter them into the register as registers close at 9am. **Please help your child be on time by ensuring they pass through the school gates by 8.50 to allow them the time to be in class by 8.55am.**

At the start of the school day, the gates open at 8:30am. Doors open at 8:45am when children can go into their classrooms to begin their day and be **in time for the register at 8.55am.**
