Maths

Place value- comparing and ordering numbers 1000 and above, rounding 2 and 3 digit numbers.

Addition and subtraction- introducing the formal written methods

Shape- angles, identify horizontal/vertical/perpendicular/ and parallel lines


Fractions- introducing 8ths.

Time- converting between analogue and 12 hour digital time, introduce 24 hour clock.

Help at home: Maths skills are taught and often applied in a problem linked to the text or project. Therefore it is always valuable to practice skills such as quick recollection of times tables as often as you can at home.

Over the half term children will have opportunities to develop their instruction and report writing skills. **Help at home** by practicing instruction writing skills, for example write the instructions for making a cup of tea. Encourage them to use a variety of imperative verbs ('bossy verbs') and to think about the layout (bullet points, sequence)

PSHE

As part of our project we will be discussing empathy and thinking of others. We are developing the idea of citizenship and giving to others. **Help at home** by encouraging your child to do something for someone else and letting us know about it.

YEAR 3 PROJECT

Can you plan and organise a charity event to raise funds for an Indian Charity?

The aim of the project is to develop citizenship, empathy, planning and problem solving skills as well as the background knowledge they will need to have on India and tea growing linked to their text.

Science

In science we will be focussing on nutrition and the human body. **Help at home** by designing a healthy meal, thinking about the essential food groups.

Can you make an exciting way of giving information about the human body, for example a model or a lift the flap diagram etc.

Geography

The children will learning about the different biomes in India in order to work out the best tea growing areas and to produce a 'Tea Growers Guide'.

Help at home by becoming more familiar with where India is on a map.

You could also research and write a fact file about India.

Make a map of the biomes in India.

Art

Using the illustrations from the class text as inspiration the children will be developing their skills using oil pastels to create landscapes.

Help at home by exploring artists such as Katsushika- a Japanese artist who created landscape images. Choose a favourite landscape image to describe the colours, tones, and patterns.
