MATHS

BINGO

Use repeated groups of flowers or leaves to help you count forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s!	Use real money to go shopping with your parent. Can you pay using the correct coins or work out the change?	Draw pictures of some 2D shapes you see outside and discuss their properties.
Find out about your family or friends by creating and carrying out a survey about their favourite things.	Find 3D shapes within your home. Name them and discuss their properties.	Use objects to share equally. Can you decide if the amounts are odd or even?
Practise your number bonds to 10 and 20. Ask a family member to test your speed!	Make numbers by counting out building blocks, sticks or drinking straws and then practise writing the number correctly.	Make two groups of your toys and add them together.

Create a wanted poster for a book character. Use a range of noun phrases to describe the character!	Write a postcard to a friend or family member about a trip or an adventure you have had. Focus on using time phrases like <i>next</i> and <i>then</i> .	Write an introduction about yourself for your new teacher. Remember to think about the best adjectives to describe yourself.
Keep a diary. Think about how you will include your feelings and the different of different words you can choose from (try not to just use happy or sad!).	Describe what you hope to do in school next year. What are your hopes and dreams for year 2?	Be inspired by nature or the weather to write a shape poem. Maybe include some rhyming words!
Design and make a building or model. Remember to include a name, labels and description.	Create some instructions for how to complete a puzzle or solve a game. Take care with your handwriting!	Use your toys to plan and act out a short story then write what happens, or what some of your toys say to each other.

Write a book review for a friend or sibling. Don't forget to give it a star rating and draw some illustrations!	Design and build a reading den and read your book inside it!	Pick a character from one of your favourite books. Write a letter to them. What advice are you going to give them?
Quiz time! Can you create a quiz about your favourite book?	Calling phonics experts! Spot tricky words and any split digraphs in your book.	Loved a book? Why not design the front cover of the sequel. How will you entice a reader and capture what the book is about?
Name as many books as possible that have animals in them.	Read a non-fiction book and wow your family with some fun facts!	Read out loud to a family member or friend. Try to use different voices for the characters!
